The Trust does have community liaison learning disability nurses whose role is to form a vital link between the acute hospitals and the Community Learning Disability Team. The main aim is to link with key practitioners, departments and wards to support when people with learning disabilities access the acute trust.

- Provide advice and support in decision making
- Support with the facilitation of reasonable adjustments
