- 3. Two part time band 3
- 4. Yes they will be advertised shortly.
- 5. Yes. When there are no suitable candidates applying for audiology positions or a suitable candidate is chosen and we await them to complete recruitment checks.
- 6. Two locum audiologist and 1 part-time locum audiologist
- 7. They are employed at band 6, the rates are not capped. They are paid through the 247 Time process. Most audiology locums are based in London, therefore the Trust has to increase our rate in order to compete.
- 8. Yes. The Trust has adopted 247 time process
- 9. Weekly salary.
- 10. £12.25K
- 11. We have recruited two audiologists who will take over from the two full time audiology locums once the recruitment process has been completed. The Trust has also recruited a band 4 full time trainee audiologist to cover the part time audiology locum.
- 12. The locum agencies send through details of a suitable audiology locum. Once the candidate has been chosen they go through the usual trust recruitment checks. Newly qualified locums will start at a lower band 6 rate than those that have had several years' experience.
