8. The name of the person in Procurement responsible for the CRRT contract in your Trust.

9. Date of the next tender for CRRT services.

10. A copy of the previous successful tender for CRRT services.

The Trust considers the names and contact details requested exempt under Freedom of Information Act 2000 Section 40(2) (personal information) as it relates to the personal information of employees.
