RE: Immunology- Changes to thyroid peroxidase (TPO) antibody reporting:

We have been informed by the Immunology laboratory at East Kent University Hospitals NHS Trust that as of 18 March 2019 there is a change in reference range for TPO antibody. This is due to a change in method.

The new recommended normal range is <5.6 IU/mL

Any result \geq 5.6 IU/L is a positive result. Please note, there is no equivocal range.

The following comment will be issued on all reports:

TPO antibody results are of no diagnostic value in euthyroid patients. They are most useful in patients with sub clinical hypothyroidism to assess risk of progression to hypothyroidism.
