I am writing in response to your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in relation to Surgical tools.

You asked:

- 1) The number of instances in which a surgical instrument has been left inside a patient's body following a surgical procedure between 2015 and 2019 (up to present day and itemised by year).
- For each instance, please list:
- a) the type of instruments found during this time and where in the body they were discovered.
- b) The surgical procedure that was taking place when instrument was left inside body.
- c) The patient's outcome, i.e. if anyone has become seriously ill as a result of leaving an surgical instrument inside the body of a patient or if anyone has died as a result of leaving a surgical instrument inside the body of a patient. (if this exceeds the scope of the request please inform me before omitting it).
- d) How many people have taken legal action against the Trust as a result of a surgeon leaving a surgical instrument inside the body of a patient. (if this exceeds the scope of the request please inform me before omitting it).
