Freedom of Information Act 2000

I am writing in response to your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in relation to Trampoline related injuries.

The number of admissions to the Accident and Emergency Department for trampoline related injuries, during the following periods:

2011-2012 2012-2013 2013-2014 2014-2015 2015-2016 2016-2017 (to date)

If you have the information, please can you detail the kind of injury sustained e.g. Head injury or spinal injury.

The A&E coding would not show what had caused the injury only what the injury was. In order to find out further detail the notes of every patient who came into A&E for those years would need to be manually read.

The Trust has estimated that it will cost more than the appropriate limit to consider your request. The appropriate limit is specified in regulations and represents the estimated cost of one person spending $3\frac{1}{2}$ working days in determining whether the Trust holds the information, locating, retrieving and extracting the information. Under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 the Trust is not obliged to comply with your request and we will not be processing your request further.
