Is the STP part of the "Aspiring ICS" programme?


Does the STP have a planned date to become an ICS/shadow ICS?

## STP response:


1. The Sustainability and Transformation Partnership has a smaller area of focus on working across all NHS hospital trusts and commissioners on operational issues such winter, workforce and change programmes requiring a 'whole system' approach – and has a senior management team in place as below. Four of these posts are full time posts and two are part-time (note the STP Chief Executive role is a dual role and includes Accountable Officer for

the Kent and Medway CCGs).



The Kent and Medway Sustainability and Transformation Partnership (STP) hosts a range of transformation programmes delivering joined up working, improved patient care, and greater efficiencies and productivity for the Kent and Medway system.


The eight Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) across Kent and Medway have agreed to share an interim senior management team as below:



- 2. The total number of budgeted whole time equivalent people working on the STP, and currently in post, is 34.2 WTE.
- 3. Our draft <u>Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP)</u> for Kent and Medway sets out how we think services need to change over the next five years to achieve the right care for people for decades to come. It will help us deliver the <u>Five Year Forward View</u>, which sets out the national vision for health and social care service.

4. Our current governance structure is shown below. A recent refresh of this introduced a Non-Executive Director Group, which will meet for the first time in early 2019. Programme and Delivery Boards are reviewed regularly and may change depending on the needs of individual programmes.



- 5. The STP has no plans currently to split into separate areas or join other STP/ICS.
