Maidstone main hospital building has a pressed steel cladding decorative facade which has no ACM and is at its highest elevation 7.8 meters

PET CT Building new build (Maidstone 2017) approximate elevation 4 meters cladding type Trespa Meteon standard panel

Tunbridge Wells Hospital at its highest elevation is 33.6 meters, cladding type is 55mm/57mm Kingspan Thermapitch TP10 – encapsulated PIR (not ACM)
