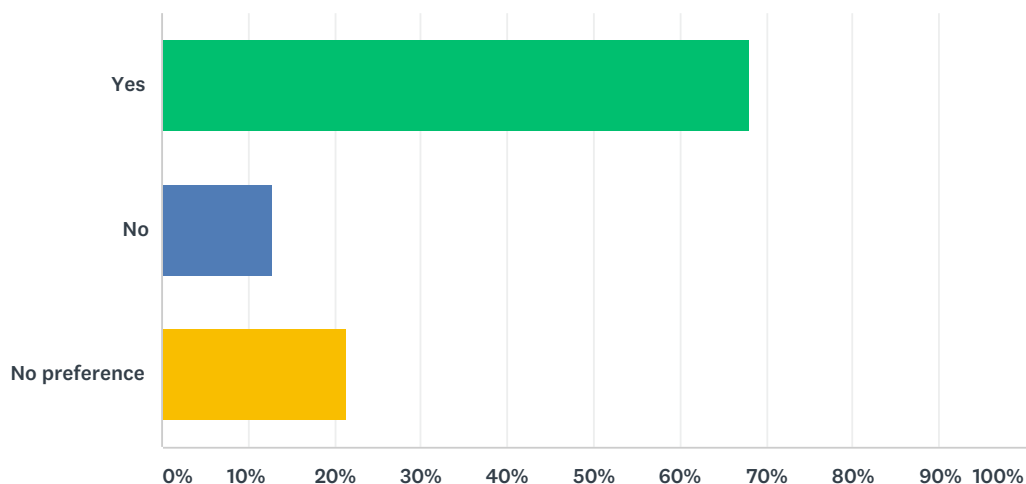


## Q1 Would you prefer a video conference call rather than having to travel to a venue?

Answered: 47 Skipped: 1

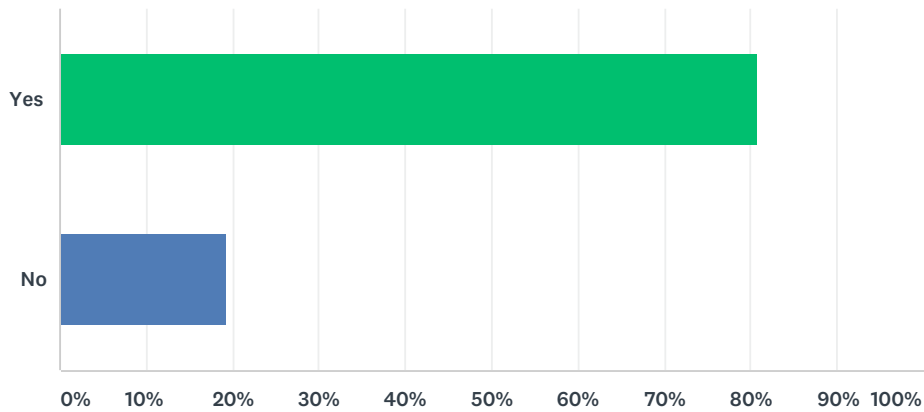

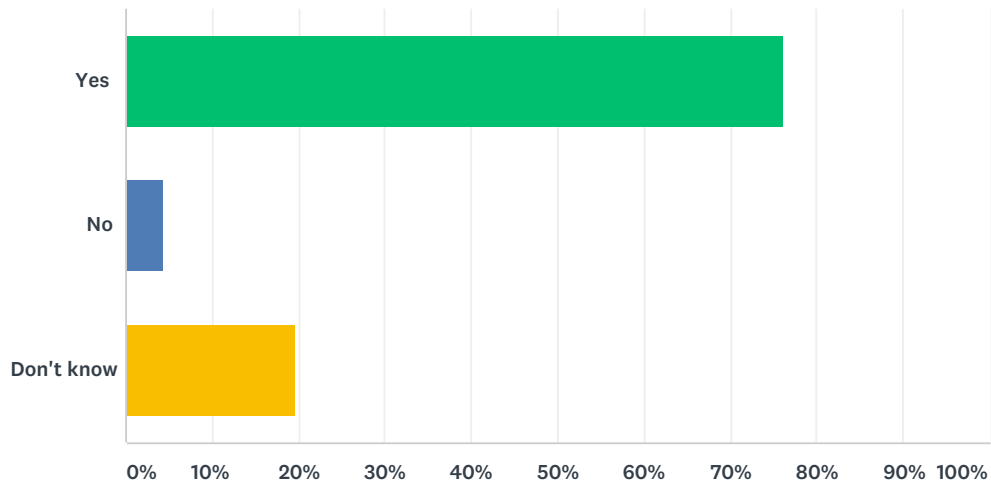

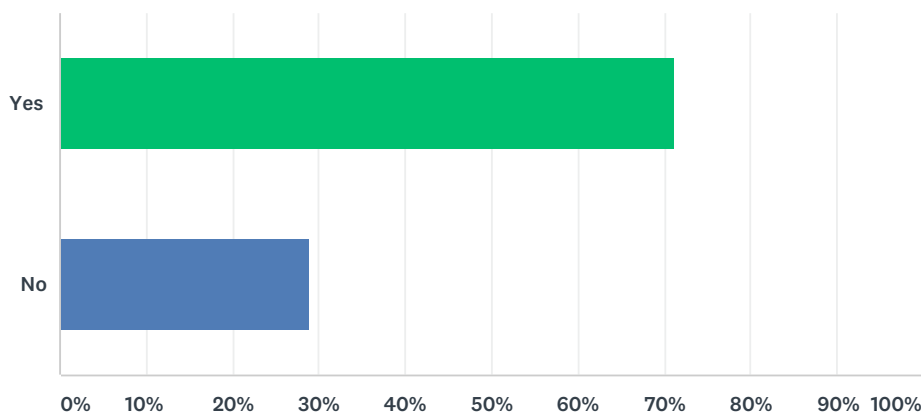

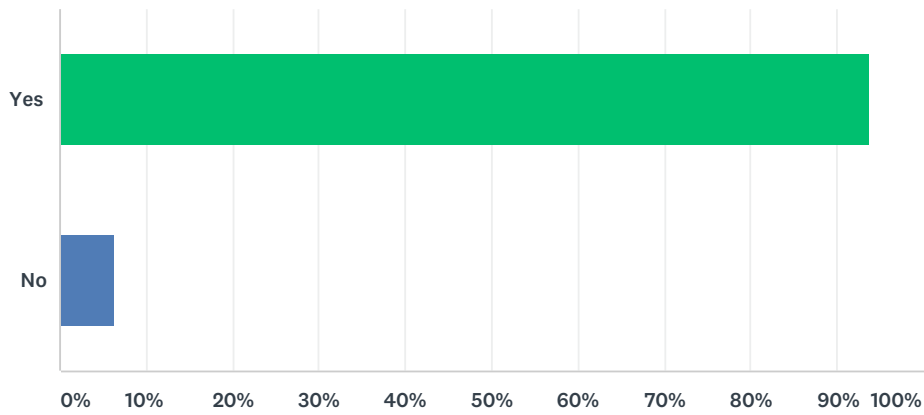

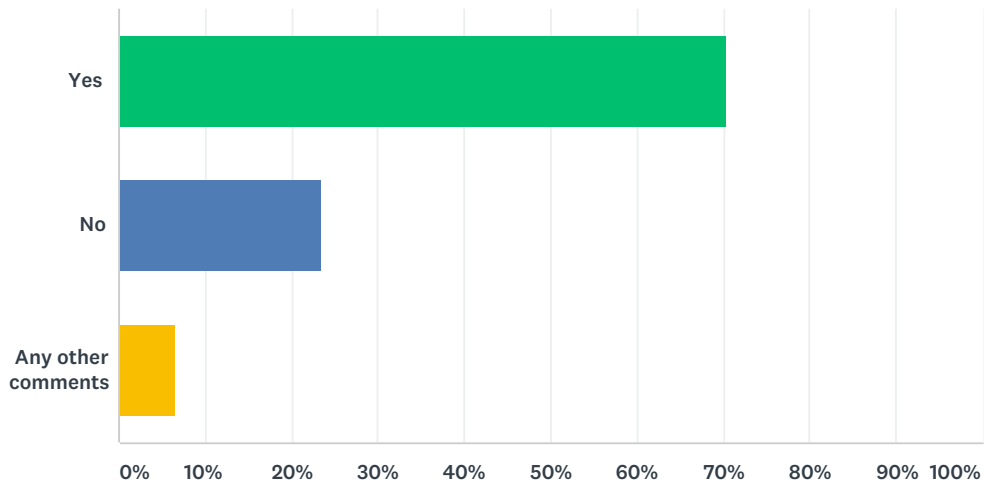

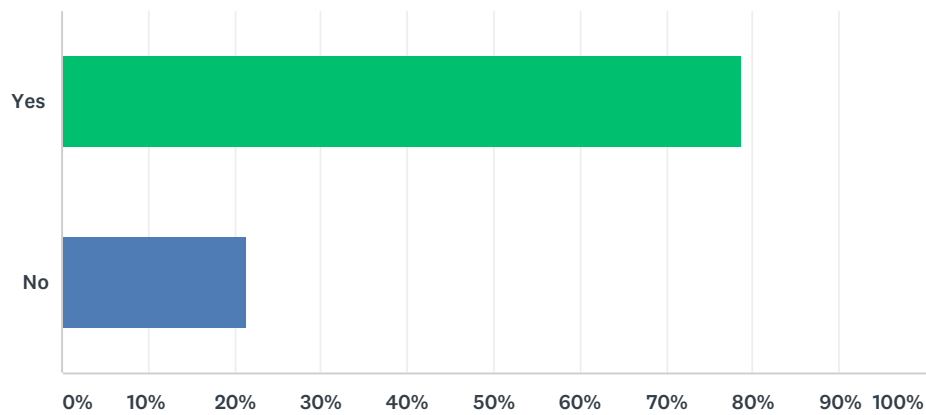
