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Spotlight on: Staff Appraisals

MTW launched electronic staff appraisals this year for non-medical staff. By the end of the appraisal cycle in July we hit 83.4% compliance.

Your appraisal documents will stay in your MTW Learning profile and remain accessible but cannot be changed once both appraiser and appraisee have signed it off. This means that staff can review identified training requirements and revisit objectives with ease throughout the year.

The Learning & Libraries team have worked hard to support the move to electronic appraisals this year, and now that we are at the end of the cycle, we will take the comments and feedback we have received from Trust staff and work with our developer to further improve the appraisal system.

BMJ Best Practice takes you quickly and accurately to the latest evidence based information, covering over 30 specialties. There are more than 250 calculators, patient information, and condensed Cochrane Reviews.

Log in with your NHS Open Athens Account and set up a personal account to use the smartphone app, and have rapid access in your pocket.



You can also earn CME/ CPD accreditation points from using the database when you set up and use your own account; why not start using it today?

A word about certificates

- Training certificates are not sent automatically
- They are available in you MTW Learning account after we have marked the register, or upon completion of e-learning.
- They will be there for 40 days post-training
- We cannot create certificates for historic events but you can view all training you have undertaken using your 'Reports' in MTW Learning.



Basic Life Support

Our BLS courses are fully booked through to November, and booking fast in December. We cannot schedule more sessions, but **you** can help **us** by CANCELLING a space when you know you cannot attend; we operate waiting lists for BLS and can fill gaps when we know we have them.

Between June and September 2019, 221 people booked BLS sessions and failed to attend. This is the equivalent of 5 additional sessions.

MTW Learning Fast Facts:

1st June 2019-1st September 2019:

- 2300 staff booked 6953 spaces on classroom based training sessions and marked as attended by the team
- 1365 spaces were lost due to staff not attending scheduled training that they had booked.
- 892 staff have completed 2240 e-learning courses
- All training, both mandatory courses and those designed to support life long learning can be booked, and
 cancelled, via your MTW Learning profile except where pre-approval to attend is required by the trainer.

Nurse& Midwife Revalidation

The Nurse Revalidation Module is now live in the MTWLearning system for our nursing and midwifery staff. It is simple to use and there's a video demo on the page to help. It's a really easy optional tool for recording all your re-validation data – it even puts your records into the correct NMC format for your submission.
