5) What percentage of your Trust energy consumption comes from fossil fuels?

6) Is your Trust taking any steps to reduce its energy consumption from fossil fuels? If so, please outline these steps.

7) What percentage of your Trust's vehicle fleet uses:

- Petrol or diesel vehicles
- Hybrid vehicles
- Electric vehicles

8) Does your Trust have a policy on reducing the use of single-use plastics (including for clinical and/or non-clinical items)? If so, please provide this policy.

6) The Trust has an SDMP that is seeking to reduce the electrical and gas consumption through the efficient operation of equipment, selected upgrade of equipment and controls and upgrade of windows

7) What percentage of your Trust's vehicle fleet uses:

- o Petrol or diesel vehicles 100%
- o Hybrid vehicles 0%
- o Electric vehicles 0%

8) The Trust does not have a policy on reducing plastic in the clinical area.

We do include a question about reduction of waste in our tenders – although most clinical products are now procured nationally via NHSSC so they have effectively become our conduit for that.

9) The Trust has received a total of £2.2m from Salix for the upgrade of lighting to LED Maidstone Hospital and Tunbridge Wells Hospital
