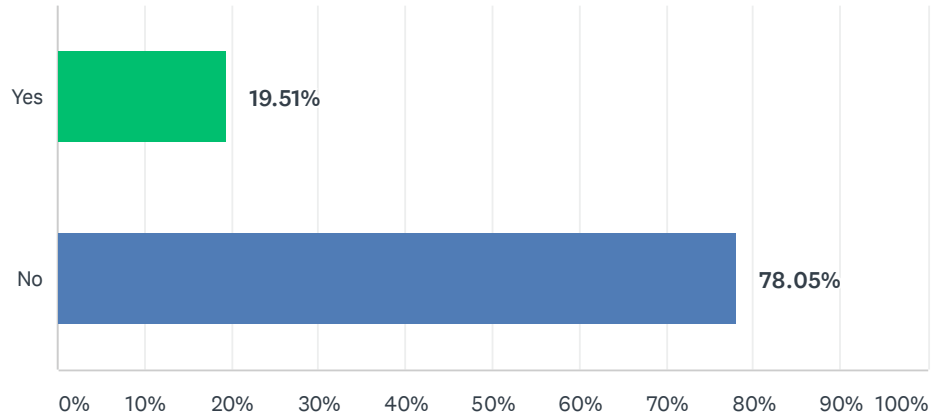


Q1 Did you find case 779 difficult in round I

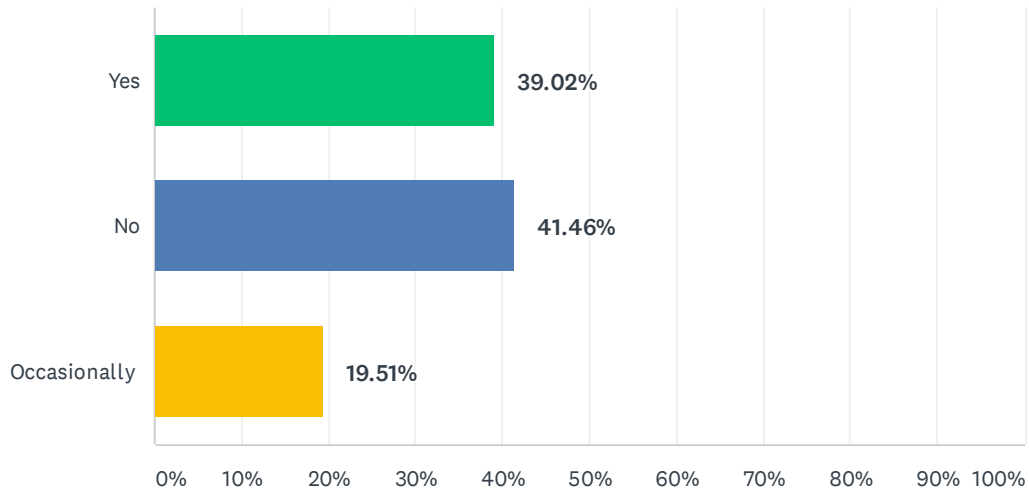

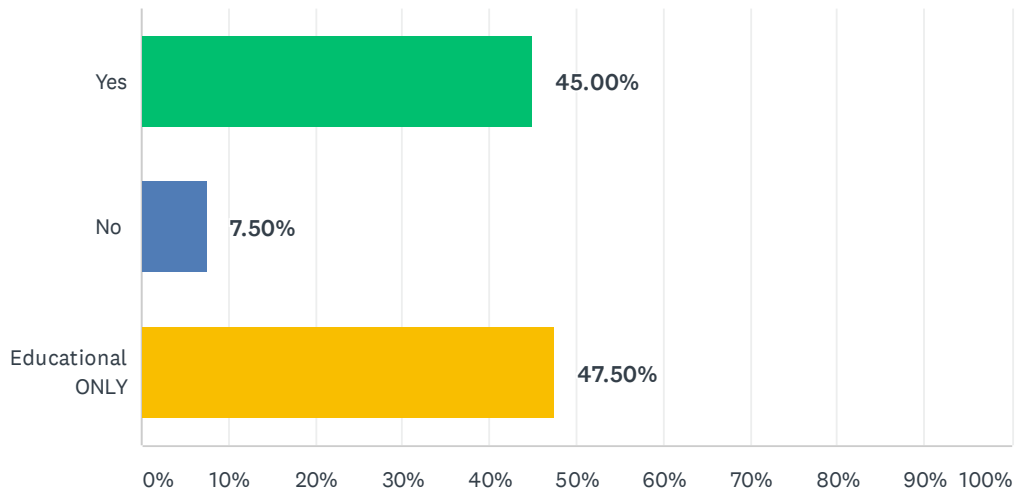
