- 5. The number of food outlets TWH has 4 and MGH has 5
- a. Yes (vending)
- b. Facilities are available on all wards for staff.
- 6. There are approx. 52 chilled water machines available to patients/visitors and 25 for staff use only.(offices, theatres, secure areas etc.)
- 7. Yes, tea & coffee is available from catering
- 8. 1,062 staff lockers are provided at TWH and lockers are provided at Maidstone

- 12. There is a Drs Mess on each site and other break out areas for staff are available.
- a. Yes staff marquees are provided on both sites to allow staff to move away from work areas.
- 13. free food and drink; currently free parking, wingman marquees for rest relaxation and refreshments (staff only to keep it a "safe space"), restaurants are closed to visitors / patients providing a staff only area to rest relax and eat (safe spaces), night café for staff, free travel between hospital sites, free bus travel on any direct route to the hospitals, program of improving shower and changing facilities, improving bike security to cycle to work, direct referral to

physiotherapy and dermatology, access to on-site psychology services for 1:2:1 or team support, direct access to NHS Mental Health services on site, previous clubs are being re-established (book club, film club Thai chi, walk and talk groups, art clubs), physical activity promotion and events for staff supported by Physiotherapy Team, wellbeing-conversations for all staff (as part of appraisal to ensure compliance), self-help materials through intranet; apps; web portal; bespoke video clips on wellbeing topics, mental health training roll out for staff and managers, in support of psychological wellbeing and enabling staff to be themselves at work and bring their whole selves to work; safe-space champions to raise concerns of any nature; staff networks – Cultural and Ethnic Minority; LGBTQ+; DisAbility Networks.
