- e. Nursing associates, registered nursing, midwifery and allied health professionals in the NHS (in England) are eligible for the CPD funding. This funding settlement has been secured and agreed with HM Treasury specifically as part of the Department of Health and Social Care's negotiations for the NHS workforce in England. The CPD funding provides an individual development fund for frontline clinical professionals to:
- Equip them with new clinical skills to enhance the care they provide to patients and develop their careers including progression through management levels up to executive leadership
- Support staff in moving between sectors, for example by enabling nurses and AHPs in hospitals to move to new roles in primary care and community care, supporting improved primary care access and out of hospital care
- Support the maintenance of their continuing professional registration by helping them to meet requirements from their professional regulators
