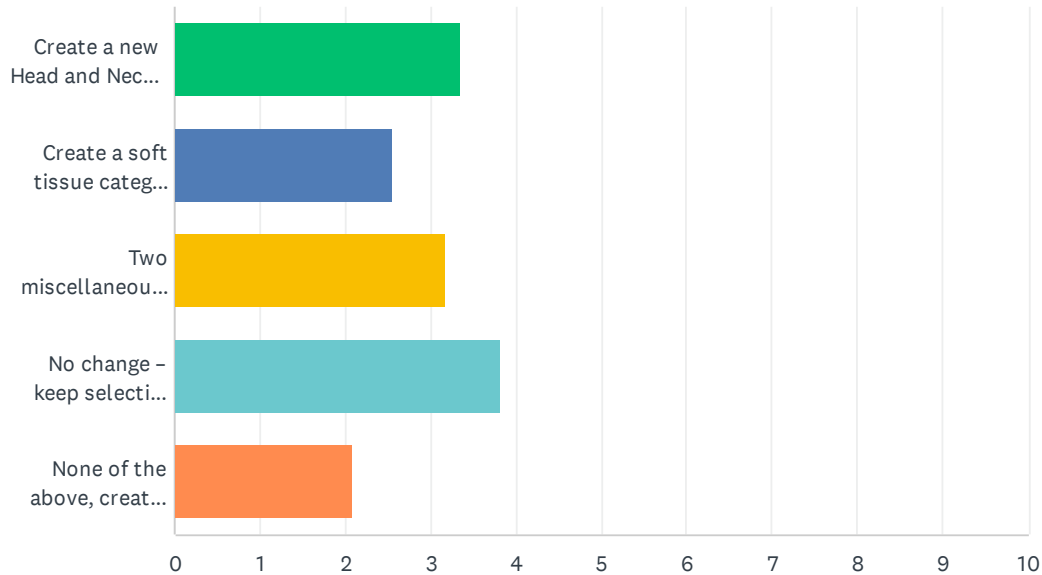


Q1 Which of these options for the 10th category would you prefer? Please indicate your preference (1 = 1st choice, 4 = least preferred)
