Freedom of Information Act 2000

I am writing in response to your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in relation to oath of office.

You asked: All questions are shown as received by the Trust. Please could you confirm in writing:

The oath of office of every employee paid by the people to serve the people. The name of your Public Liability Insurer and associated Bond numbers. Silence is acquiescence, aiding, abetting, default, dishonesty and deceit.

Trust response:

Consideration of requests without reference to the identity or motives of the applicant

Section 8(1)(b) of the FOIA requires that a request for information must include the real name of the requester.

- 14. If the requester;
- fails to provide a name;
- can't be identified from the name provided (for example because they have only used their first name or initials); or,
- is using an obvious pseudonym,

Then their request won't meet the requirements of section 8(1)(b) and will technically be invalid. The Trust will not be processing this request.
