

Pathology Tests Outside Current Scopes of Accreditation

UKAS requires that Pathology services accredited to BS EN ISO 15189 (GEN 6) make their users aware of any tests within their repertoire that are not included in their scope of accreditation. This is usually due to an extension to scope (ETS) application and is a routine delay for any significant change within the laboratory. Any such examinations are listed below.

Where examinations are added to our service, users can have confidence in the results of these tests, as the laboratories will operate under the same Quality Management System as for accredited tests and will usually be working to achieve accreditation of the tests.
