



## Entering responses using EQALite

### How do I log in?

1. Go to [www.histopathologyeqa.org](http://www.histopathologyeqa.org)
2. Enter your email address as your username (this email address needs to be the address that you registered with the scheme)
3. Click "Reminder" if you have forgotten/never had your password.
4. An email will be sent to you with your password.
5. Enter this password
6. You can change this password, update your address etc via the tab labelled "your details".

### Entering Responses

EQALite allows participants to be a member of more than one EQA Scheme. To swap between schemes, use the scheme dropdown at the top-right of most pages.

1. Select the South East England General Histopathology EQA Scheme. Selecting another scheme should change the scheme, but very rarely you may need to click GO

2. The list of circulations will appear.

3. Click on the open circulation

4. List of cases appear across screen

8. Enter a single free text diagnosis and a weighting (confidence level) for this diagnosis. If you are 100% confident of this diagnosis, enter a weighting of 10.

Enter up to 10 diagnoses and weighting up to a total maximum of 10.

9. You must separate different diagnoses onto separate lines and provide weightings that adds up to 10. If you want to add a second (or third) diagnosis, click ADD and apply weightings (confidence level) to each diagnosis. The sum of all weightings must total 10

Enter up to 10 diagnoses and weighting up to a total maximum of 10.

10. If you want to stop and not submit answers then click SAVE. You can print out answers as well.
11. When you have completed all your answers, click "COMPLETE" to submit the answers. **Once submitted your answers cannot be changed.** You will not be able to submit the answers if you have missed a tab and you are not exempt from that diagnostic category.
12. In the list of Circulations a date will appear in the Completed column confirming that you have completed that circulation.
13. Do not confuse Submit Cases with completing responses. Submit Cases is for sending in slides for new cases.
